Post-Doctoral Research Fellows

The Arise&Win project is a 2-year research project at the College of Medicine, University of Ibadan in partnership with researchers from Douglas Hospital Research Centre, Montreal, Canada. The project aims to co-develop an intervention that will enable self-employed young Nigerian women to be more resilient in the face of significant life events and family emergencies; and improve their physical health, mental health, and work outcomes. The study location is Oyo State.

Job Description

The postdoctoral research fellows will support the data analysis and writing up of this project that focuses on the health and working lives of self-employed young women. The post-doctoral research fellow will:

- a. Participate in research planning, the refinement of research questions and the design of study protocols
- b. Conduct literature reviews
- c. Support data collection
- d. Carry out data cleaning and management
- e. Carry out data analysis
- f. Write up the research findings as peer-reviewed publications
- g. Present the project findings at conferences
- h. Participate in knowledge translation activities (e.g. stakeholder meetings, social media and press releases)

Selection Criteria

Essential

- a. PhD in social sciences/ health sciences/life sciences/humanities/public health/mental health, psychology, sociology, communications
- b. Interest in conducting research on employment and wellbeing
- c. Experience conducting quantitative/qualitative research
- d. Experience using qualitative analysis packages (e.g. Atlas.ti, Nvivo) or quantitative statistical software (e.g. SPSS, R, Stata)
- e. Published first-authored and co-authored papers in peer-reviewed publications in their field
- f. Presented at conferences, seminars, and/or workshops
- g. Experience working as part of a team

Desirable

- h. Ability to communicate technical results in a non-technical manner to reach a broader audience
