An Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree (EMJMD) is a prestigious, integrated, international study programme, jointly delivered by an international consortium of higher education institutions. Students at Master's level from all over the world can apply.

Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters are high-level integrated study programmes at master level. The programmes are designed and delivered by an international partnership of higher education institutions from different countries worldwide. There are 149 programmes to choose from!

Erasmus+ funds scholarships for students to take part in these programmes. The masters programmes themselves offer these scholarships to the best-ranked student applicants worldwide, in annual application rounds.

EU scholarships cover the cost of a student's participation in the programme, travel, and a living allowance.



# How to apply?



First you should consult the online Catalogue of Erasmus Mundus masters programmes ([https://www.eacea.ec.europa.eu/scholarships/emjmd-catalogue\\_en](https://www.eacea.ec.europa.eu/scholarships/emjmd-catalogue_en)).

Each programme's website contains all the information you need on content, entry requirements and the universities for you to decide if this is the right programme for you.

The programme's website will also take you through all the steps of the online application process. A new batch of selected Erasmus Mundus Masters is added to the list each summer. Most consortia will require applications to be submitted between October and January, for courses starting the following academic year.
